Women´s labour – a key driver in globalisation

Globalisation effects the whole labour market. More and more women are part of the global market, but mostly they work in poor conditions and belong to the new class called “working poor”.

The reality shows that women are often working part-time or that they get payed less than men in the same position. That’s the reason why we have the “Equal Pay Day”. This date symbolizes how far into the year women must work to earn what men earned in the previous year. Often it happens at the end of March, so women must work one quarter more than men for the same wage.

In the seminar we want to deal with the situation of women in the labour markets and the influences on globalisation. We will discuss the issue of the “working poor” and the global effects on the labour market.

You will get to know different perspectives and we will have a deep dive into discrimination on structural, interpersonal and institutional level.

We will exchange our views and discuss our experiences on the topic. Together we will debate solution approaches for different situations.
