Students from Africa, Asia, Latin America and Eastern Europe

Almost half of the international students in Baden-Württemberg are from the countries of Africa, Asia, Latin America and Eastern Europe.



Around 80 percent of these students are the so called „free movers“. Most of them support their studies themselves and earn during their studies. They don't receive any scholarship and there are no special educational services for them.

STUBE BW – Development Education Programme in Baden-Württemberg

STUBE-BW is the only programme in Baden-Württemberg, which provides these students with an opportunity to exchange their experience and gain knowledge in the field of development.

STUBE opens up a space for exploration of sustainable education and development as well as for the individual future planning.

STUBE's educational programmes sensitize students to the questions of development and are open to students of any specialization. Participants obtain interesting information about current global issues, can exchange their views and build networks.

For many students from Africa, Asia, Latin America and Eastern Europe, STUBE is also „a home away from home“ and gives them a feeling of security.

STUBE-Programmes

STUBE offers

- Weekend Seminars
- Study Days
- Half-Day Workshops

The seminars are largely interactive. Supported by specialized **lectures and presentations, films, work groups, exercises, role plays** and other **activities**, participants acquire knowledge, exchange ideas and jointly look for possible solutions.



Examples of seminar topics

- Introduction to developmental policy
- Gender Equality
- Renewable Energy
- World Nutrition and Land Grabbing
- Peace and Conflict Regulation

STUBE works with political and economic organizations, as well as civil societies and NGOs. Thereby STUBE supports the participants in learning further aspects and practical application of a particular issue and build up their networks.

Scholarship for internship and study visit abroad (BPSA)

BPSA is a scholarship for students who want to conduct study-related research or do an internship in their home country. This programme enables them to get to know the realities of the job market at home and to find out ways for their professional integration upon return. They can also check how their newly acquired knowledge can be practically implemented in their country of origin.

They can analyze the social and political reality in their countries, work on the fears associated with return and develop new perspectives for their personal and professional future.

Disseminator Training Global Learning

Global Learning means realizing the interrelations and interdependencies between the countries of the North and the South.

STUBE-students are particularly suitable to depict these interrelations and the living conditions of people in their home countries.



The seminars convey the contents and methods of Global Learning. After a practical assignment, which is accompanied by a coaching, the participants receive a certificate and are taught at schools and in municipalities as speakers. The STUBE-students receive a fee for this.
