How to become a Global Citizen?

Many people in Germany have limited knowledge about the people and life in countries of the Global South. This leads to clichéd ideas and prejudices against people living here from these countries. Students from Africa, Asia, Latin America, and Eastern Europe are very well suited to convey the situation of people in their countries authentically. They can illustrate global connections—like what chocolate consumption in the Global North really has to do with child labor in the Global South, or how hunger is connected to food waste—using concrete examples more authentically than textbooks ever could. The students also benefit: they can share knowledge and experiences about their country and learn to speak as a presenter. This is an advantage for their future professional life.

In this workshop, you'll learn how to report on people and life situations in your countries in a methodically varied way and how to present global connections.

You'll get to know engaging methods that actively involve the audience and have the chance to try out being a speaker yourself.

The workshop is held in cooperation with EPIZ (Entwicklungspädagogisches Informationszentrum). This organization connects university students with schools, where they work as guest speakers.
