Migration – Chance and Challenge for Individuals, Communities and States

Throughout history, human beings have constantly moved from place to place for various reasons – voluntarily or forced by circumstances beyond their control. One motivation for migration has always been curiosity and the wish to learn about “other” cultures and languages. People search for new educational or job opportunities. Others flee from violent conflicts, persecution, human rights violations, poverty or natural disasters in hope of freedom, safety and peace. In that sense, migration is neither new, nor extraordinary. However, each and every migrant experience is unique and dependent on a specific context. The causes of migration may change over time, also the means and circumstances facilitating or hindering migrants in their aspirations.

In this seminar, we will learn about different types of migration. Building on a rightsbased perspective, we want to assess chances, challenges, and risks for migrating individuals, as well as the societies of origin and destination. Taking into account historical continuencies and current developments influencing debates about migration, we will discuss ethical questions, (political) responsibilities, and forms of civil activism regarding the issue of migration.

In order to deepen our perspective on the situations of migrants world wide and in Germany, we will use interactive exercises and take time to compare and contrast personal views and migration experiences.
