Do we need weapons to build peace?

The Discrepancy of Peacebuilding Strategies and ongoing Arm Exports

In 2019 we still have a lot of conflicts going on in the world. People are displaced and living in fear. We need to end these conflicts as soon as possible. The seminar will focus on the discrepancy of ongoing weapon exports and peacebuilding strategies to end these conflicts.

Peace is difficult to define. Is peace the same as security or is there a difference? We will look interactively on the different definitions and your understanding of peace.

We will expound the problem of colonial aspects in the implementation of post-war peace arrangements. We will look critically at the liberal peace-keeping approach and discuss how peace and economics are related.

We will discuss following questions:

Do we really need weapons to end violence conflicts in the world?

Or why are Germany and other countries still exporting so many arms to the whole world?

There are not only international conflicts. Every one of us has conflict in our personal life. There are strategies to deal with conflicts in our personal life. You will reflect on your own conflict management. We will learn different methods and strategies to deal with conflict and to react properly in conflict situations.
